

Our school has successfully implemented two projects, “Total Low Carbon Campus” and “Let’s Save energy & Reduce carbon release”, with the generous funding of \$637,100 from Environment and Conservation Fund and Environmental Campaign Committee in April 2011. Through these two projects, we have replaced 852 energy efficient sets of “T5/LED Lights” and installed “Solar Heat Shield Coating” and “Heat-proof paint” in classrooms and on roof for heat protecting respectively.

These two projects could surely reduce the electricity consumption for indoor lighting and significant amount of heat to enter the school campus, maintaining a suitable room temperature and cutting down electricity consumption for air-conditioning, and in turn reducing the emission of exhaust fumes from power stations. Our energy improvement works started in September 2011, and completed right before the Christmas holiday.
